


What documents are required from applicants?

- 1- Application form,
- 2- Photocopy of identity card,
- 3- Residence certificate obtained from the Population Directorate or via e-government
- 4- Farmer Registration System (FRS) certificate obtained from the Provincial or District Directorates of Agriculture for the last 2 years (2024-2025), showing the affected parcel information,
- 5- A statement signed by the mukhtar and 2 azas confirming that the user of the land, which cannot be documented with a FRS record, uses the affected parcel.
- 6- A statement or declaration signed by the mukhtar and two aza confirming that the expropriated land, owned by the treasury, forestry, pasture, mukhtar, or other public institutions and organizations, has been used for agricultural purposes for a long time, and, if available a compensation or lease agreement.
- 7- For those requesting livestock and beekeeping support (currently engaged in production), an FRS certificate.
- 8- For those engaged in livestock and beekeeping that cannot be documented with a FRS record, a declaration signed by the mukhtar and 2 aza.

How will applications be evaluated?

Independent experts will conduct face-to-face interviews with applicants. Decisions on who will benefit from the support packages will be made, ensuring that they are feasible and sustainable for those who meet the eligibility criteria. Applications from households with vulnerable individuals will be prioritized.



INFORMATION BROCHURE FOR USERS OF AFFECTED AGRICULTURAL LANDS

What is Antalya Alanya Motorway Project?

Antalya-Alanya Motorway Project Construct-Operate-Transfer Model Construction, Operation, and Transfer Tender was held on December 15, 2023, and the Implementation Agreement for the Project was signed between Antalya Alanya Motorway Construction Investment and Operation Inc., a member of the Limak Group of Companies, and the General Directorate of Highways on October 14, 2024.

Antalya-Alanya Motorway Project starts at the Serik Junction then heads east, following the corridor at the foot of the Taurus Mountains within the boundaries of the districts of Serik and Manavgat, ending at the Alanya Junction North of Konaklı, with a total length of 122 km.



What is the Livelihood Restoration Program?

The Livelihood Restoration Program developed to compensate agricultural land owners and users affected by land acquisition for the Antalya Alanya Motorway Project for any agricultural land and assets on it (such as greenhouses and fruit trees). The program includes packages that support agricultural and livestock activities.

What are the support packages?

Package 1 - TRAININGS

Agricultural Production Training
Livestock Farming Training
Beekeeping Training

Package 2 – INPUT SUPPORTS

Agricultural Input Supports
a) Seedling, Sapling and Seed Input Support
b) Agricultural Equipment/Material Supports

Livestock Input Supports

a) Feed and Forage Seed Support
b) Livestock Equipment Support

Beekeeping Input Supports

a) Hive and Beekeeping Material Support (for existing beekeepers who want to expand their business)

Package 3 – LEASING SUPPORT

Replacement Land Rent Support
If the affected land is not owned by the person and the person has found new land, 1 year of rent support is provided.

Who can apply?

All individuals who use affected land to generate agricultural income (including both official and unofficial users) can apply for support. This support will be provided in proportion to the level of impact experienced.

Accordingly:

- Owners/shareholders of privately owned agricultural parcels (including defendants and orphan lands) – The owner/shareholder must be the person(s) who derives their livelihood /income from the land.

- Official and unofficial users of privately owned agricultural plots (including defendants and orphan lands) – These must be individuals who derive their livelihood/income from the land but are not the registered owner/shareholder of the land.

- Official and unofficial users of state-owned land used for agricultural purposes (treasury, unregistered)

- Users of registered pasture and grazing parcels within the expropriation corridor.

- Those who use the forest for official or unofficial economic activities (such as grazing gathering forest products)

- Affected households with physically and economically vulnerable members

- Official and unofficial users of privately owned parcels used as temporary facility areas

- Official and unofficial users of state-owned parcels (treasury, unregistered) used as temporary facility areas

Is it possible to receive support from more than one source?

One person can apply for a maximum of 2 support packages.

If the application approved, the applicant can benefit from both of the two packages they have selected. Applications from vulnerable groups will be given priority.

How to apply?

1. Fill out the application form (www.antalyaalanyaotoyolu.com.tr/en or from the local mukhtars offices).

2. Attach the required documents.

3. Submit your application in person to the community liaison officers or send it to the address indicated in the brochure.

4. Please note that applications not submitted within the specified time frame will not be evaluated.

Important:

The Information Text and Consent Form included in the application form must be signed.

The planned dates for accepting applications are between February 01, 2026 – December 30, 2026.

All applications within this scope will be evaluated in the order they are received.
